

Arrival by train/public transportation to Darmstadt central station

- regional and long distance traffic of the DB
- to Campus Lichtwiese via tram „Linie 2“ (about 20 minutes)

to TU Lichtwiese station Darmstadt

- regional traffic of the VIAS GmbH
- a walk of about 5 minutes to EST

starting from city centre (for example from station „Schloss“ or „Luisenplatz“) with bus „Linie L“ (or tram Linie 2“)

Arrival by car

- Exit A67 or A5 at Darmstädter Kreuz towards Darmstadt Stadtmitte (A672)
- Follow the signs directed to „TU Lichtwiese“
- Then drive (as shown in the picture) to Otto-Berndt-Straße via Eugen-Kogon-Straße
- The Mechanical-Engineering-Building L1|01 is on the left side (red Gear)
- Parking is possible in front of the building L1|01 or in the car park, cost 2,50 €/day (cash, no change)
- Parking for suppliers is possible in front of L1|01 or in the Otilie-Bock-Straße after passing the gate

Arrival from Frankfurt am Main Airport

Taxi

- Travel time about 30 min. (but longer during rush-hour traffic)

Bus „AirLiner“

- Bus from airport to Darmstadt central station or city centre („Luisenplatz“)
- From there via public transport as described on the left side of this sheet
